**“Fire Sprinkler Antifreeze System Update”

A member of the National Fire Sprinkler Association staff since 1987, Kenneth E. Isman is currently the Vice President of Engineering. He holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Fire Protection Engineering and a Masters of Science in Management, both from the University of Maryland. He is a Licensed Professional Engineer in the State of Connecticut and has been inducted as a Fellow of the Society of Fire Protection Engineers.

Mr. Isman represents the fire sprinkler industry on more than 12 technical committees of the National Fire Protection Association including the Technical Correlating Committee on Automatic Sprinklers, the Committee on Residential Sprinkler Systems, the Committee on Sprinkler System Discharge Criteria and the Committee on Fire Pumps. From 2000 to 2006 he was a member of the NFPA Standards Council.
